Best Practice no-1:

1. Title: “Prayash”- An initiative for Village Adoption

2. Objectives:

- Recognize potential of the village and confer guidance to acquire pronounced economic and social eminence.
- Assist the village to serve as a model village by achieving development in all spheres via promoting ecological farming, environmental health and well-being, also establish it as a "knowledge hub" that can generate resources for the growth of near neighbourhood.
- Community engagement by students.

3. The Context:

- Aiming at empowering underprivileged and moulding students with strong sense of ethical and humanitarian values, Goalpara college has adopted ‘Kuruabhasa’- an indigent tribal village from where a considerable number of students get enrolled in it. This alliance is intended to provide needed opportunities to the tribal populace for their all-inclusive development.

4. The Practice:

- The initiative is financed by the institution together with faculty’s contribution (**1% of earnings**) and is headed by a committee with Principal as an Advisor.
- Free classes are provided to village students by college faculties.
- School bags were distributed in Kuruabhasa LP School, Kuruabhasa MV school, and Bishnu Rabha High school for inspiring the students.
- Professional guidance via workshops, hands-on-trainings are offered to ensure socio-economic expansion.
- Student groups along with NSS and NCC unit are engaged in welfare activities.
- Collection of Feedback to evaluate the impacts of extension activities to sensitize students on social issues.

5. Evidence of Success:

- Significant amplification in pass percentage of Bishnu Rabha High School.
- Training of 125 football enthusiasts by national players Kubol Rabha, Abhijit Rabha, and Rofique Rabha.
- Awareness programme on opportunities in police service with the involvement of V V Rakesh Reddy, SP Goalpara was organized. Eight recent recruitments has marked the success of such endeavour.
- Numerous training programmes were organized to educate the villagers about selection/cultivation of edible variety of mushrooms. The villagers have successfully adopted it as an **earning root**.
- Workshops on production/application of vermicompost has resulted in preparation and profitable utilization of vermicompost in the village for green farming, also it has procured commerciality as a brand "**Krishak Bandhu**".
- College organized digital literacy awareness programme for women to familiarize digital payment applications, e-governance and cyber security, along with ICT awareness for farmers for effective farming and marketing.
- Sanitary napkins, masks, sanitizer and essential medicines were distributed among the villagers as a part of free health check-up camp and community '**Swachhata**' programme.
- Series of campaigns have been organized under direction of **Padma Shri Birubala Rabha** to eradicate misbelief and educate people against practices like witch-hunting. No cases of witch-hunting has been recorded in 'Kuruabhasa' afresh.
- Village science fair were organized to implant the spirit of innovation among students.
- NSS unit is involved in welfare activities like cleaning the public places, construction of road from **Santi-bazar to Maru-khetri**, also repairing the road-drainage system.
- College celebrated **Manchelegka festival**, prevalent among the Rabha ethnic community that serves to protect the bird Manchelegka (**Kingfisher**) with a belief that souls of their ancestors transmigrate in it. This celebration was a move to familiarize protection of migratory birds visiting **Urpad beel** each year.

6. Problems encountered and Resources required:

- Pecuniary assistance is required since insubstantial fund interrupts successful execution of objectives.
- Due to various academic commitments, the college struggles to manage time to conduct programmes in the village. Flexible timetable may help here.

Best Practice no-2:

1. Title: Vasudha: In a bid to embrace Green practices and conserve Nature

2. Objectives:

- Create environmental consciousness by encouraging eco-friendly practices in/outside the campus.
- Adopt emission reduction and energy conservation practices.
- Utilize renewable natural resources for energy generation.
- Embrace proper plans to mitigate pollution.

3. The Context:

- Goalpara college celebrates rich bio-diversity of Western Assam along with West Garo hills, Meghalaya. Considering global ecological issues, attempt has been made to familiarize environment-friendly practices in/outside the campus to ensure responsible consumption of resources and sustainable development.

4. The Practice:

- Annual Plantation Drive in/outside the campus and Green auditing is exercised.

- Green house serves for planting of indigenous orchids from Garo hills accompanying essential medicinal plants.
- An experimental garden dedicated to *Azolla* cultivation along with significant aquatic planktons as *Nostoc*, *Anabaena* having nitrogen-fixing abilities. Diverse *Arum* varieties are also a fragment of this.
- A scenic park is built and nurtured by faculty contributions.
- Organic waste are successfully recycled in vermicompost pits.
- Institution's Geo-ID forum has undertaken several initiatives to reduce institutional and societal carbon footprint and inculcate greener practices in schools of Goalpara by forming Eco-club.
- Practice of 'No Vehicle Day' **on every Thursday of the week.**
- Practice of **Reduce-Reuse-Recycle** by utilizing separate wastebins for plastic, paper, iron and glass waste.
- Practice of e-governance to reduce paper use.
- Use of energy-efficient appliances for energy conservation.
- Maintenance of 'Plastic free environment' as per government norms.
- Practice of Rain-water harvesting and use of Rain-gauge.

5. Evidence of Success:

- Green audit presents a floristic diversity of 317 trees belonging to 24 families in the campus. Trees are displayed with scientific nomenclature.
- The campus embraces 25 native orchid species of Garo hills.
- *Azolla*, *Nostoc* and *Anabaena* have been utilized as green manures. Besides, the experimental garden nurtures 20 diverse *Arum* species with medicinal and ornamental usefulness.
- **Micro-forest** development adopting '**Miyawaki Method**' in Goalpara Girls College.
- Vermicompost is serving as an organic manure for planting/farming in/outside the campus.

- Goalpara Vidyapith High School has earned “**Excellent Eco Club**” Award under National Green Corps Programme, Assam.
- Chemical wastes are effectively disposed in a brick-well through **Activated Carbon Adsorption**.
- Energy auditing is practiced. Energy-efficient lighting has resulted in effective energy saving. To minimize the dependency on electrical energy, conventional street lights in the campus have been replaced with twenty 30-Watt Solar Street lights.
- Bamboo bins are used for recycling. Paper bags made by students are considerably in use in/outside the campus.
- Harvested rainwater is utilized in Bio-Tech Hub, Chemistry laboratory and college lavatories.

6. Problems Encountered and Resources Required:

- As per energy audit report, college has adequate rooftop area sufficient for 120 kW Solar power plant installation. Financial assistance is needed here.
- Monkey menace is a hindrance in upkeeping the practices.

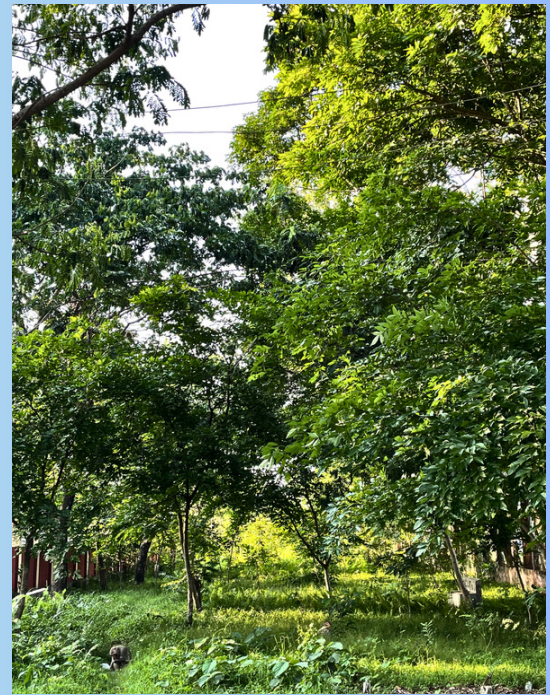




Van-Mahotsav: an annual one-week tree planting festival has been celebrated on the first week of July for the last three years.

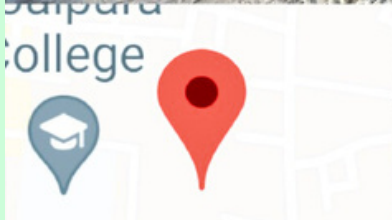
