

GOALPARA COLLEGE (AUTONOMOUS) SPOT ADMISSION POLICY 2026 -2027

Information for the applicants for Participation in SPOT ADMISSION of FYUGP Courses
2026 – 2027

KEY POINTS:

- **Registration status:**
 - ❖ If you already registered on the Samarth Admission Portal and have a valid Registration Number, you do not need to register again.
 - ❖ If you haven't registered, you can register from 13 June 2026 to 17 June 2026 (by 4:00 pm) prior to SPOT admission.
- **Prior applicants:**

If you have already applied for a course at Goalpara College (Autonomous), you don't need to re-apply. You can modify your application during the Spot Admission counselling at the admission desk.
- **Applicants with no prior application:**
 - ❖ If you have not applied for any course yet, you should apply for at least one course. You can modify your choice after counselling at the admission desk during Spot Admission.
- **How admission is determined**
 - ❖ On the spot, Application forms will be collected on 15, 16, and 17 June, 2026 from 10:00 A.M. to 12:30 P.M.
 - ❖ Applicants will be called percentage-wise (from higher to lower) and the vacant seats will be filled accordingly (% Mark as per Class XII mark sheet).
 - ❖ After counselling, admission will be granted to the selected course/subject depending on seat availability.
- **Late applicants**
 - ❖ Applicants who arrive late can still be considered for the next day round for admission subject to seat availability.

Merit score ranges and dates

15 June 2026 (subject to seat availability)

- ♣ FYUGP B.A.: Up to 60% Marks from top
- ♣ FYUGP B.Sc.: Up to 65% Marks from top
- ♣ B.Com.: Open to all

16 June 2026 (subject to seat availability)

- ♣ FYUGP B.A.: Up to 50% Marks from top
- ♣ FYUGP B.Sc.: Up to 55% Marks from top
- ♣ B.Com.: Open to all

17 June 2026 (subject to seat availability)

- ♣ All in descending order, subject to seat availability
